Master of Planning (Urban & Regional):

a) Bachelor's degree in Urban & Regional Planning/Architecture/Civil Engineering with at least 50% marks (47.5% for Schedule Caste candidate of Haryana) in aggregate.

OR

b) Equivalent degree in any relevant area.

Note:

- 1. For admission to postgraduate programmes, the candidates having qualified the required course through regular mode shall be eligible for admission.
- 2. The candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examinations may also apply for admission, but they will have to submit proof of having passed the qualifying examination.
- 3. Admission to all postgraduate programmes will be based on merit of qualifying examinations.
