

Master of Planning (Urban & Regional):

a) Bachelor's degree in Urban & Regional Planning/Architecture/Civil Engineering with at least 50% marks (47.5% for Schedule Caste candidate of Haryana) in aggregate.

OR

b) Equivalent degree in any relevant area.

Note:

1. For admission to postgraduate programmes, the candidates having qualified the required course through regular mode shall be eligible for admission.
2. The candidates who have appeared in the qualifying examinations may also apply for admission, but they will have to submit proof of having passed the qualifying examination.
3. Admission to all postgraduate programmes will be based on merit of qualifying examinations.
