## Eligibility conditions for Admission to Bachelor of Architecture Programme:

- 1. Eligibility: Passed an examination at the end of the 10+2 scheme of examination with at least 50% aggregate marks in Physics, Chemistry & Diploma Examination of the 10+2 level examination or passed 10+3 Diploma Examination with Mathematics as compulsory subject with at least 50% marks in aggregate Or 10+3 Diploma (any stream) recognized by central/State Govt. with 50% aggregate marks with Mathematics as compulsory subject of examination. Or International Baccalaureate Diploma, after 10 years of schooling, with not less than 50% marks in aggregate and with Mathematics as compulsory subject of Examination.
- (ii) **Merit list** shall be based on aggregate marks of 10+2 and NATA score (percentile) or score (percentile) of qualified JEE (Main) Paper-2 (B.Arch./B.Planning) in the ratio 50:50.
- (iii) In order to pass NATA Test a candidate must have valid NATA Score as per COA. Obtained at least 50% marks (47.5% in case of candidate belonging to SC category) in the qualifying Examination.

## Note:

- 1. Provisional admissions shall be done on the basis of online submission of application from and relevant documents. Admission shall be regularized only after the verification of the original documents.
- 2. Applicant shall be responsible for any discrepancy found at any stage of the admission process and even later. In that case, the admission shall be liable for cancellation, and it may also invite appropriate action as per law.
