Programme Objectives:

It is a vocational programme which lays emphasis on theory, with plenty of hands-on training. To excel in the field of photography, aspirants will have to devote substantial time to practical work. The participants shall receive theoretical knowledge of the basics of photography along with practical training to hone their skills as photographers. The aim is to impart the technique and nuances of photography, as also to develop a creative frame of mind.

Programme Duration: One Year

Minimum Eligibility: Candidates who have passed the Senior Secondary (10+2) or equivalent exam from a recognized boards or institutions are eligible.

Timing: At least two sessions to be held on weekends and holidays, in addition to workshops/practical's, etc.
