## Syllabus for Certificate of Proficiency in French

### Nature of the Programme

Department of Foreign Languages offers Certificate of Proficiency in French of six months duration for non-graduates, under the semester and Grade system of the University.

### Aims and Objectives

- To enable the learner to attain A1 level of Common European Framework for French
- To enable the learners to listen and understand the spoken French language which uses the elementary spoken structures.
- To enable the learners to speak and engage in simple dialogues in French.
- To enable the learners to read and understand the elementary texts in French
- To enable the learners to write the simple sentences and short paragraphs in French.
- To enable the learners to manipulate the basic grammatical structures of the language and the most essential vocabulary items.
- To expose the learners to the culture of French speaking countries

### Duration of the course

One semester, with a duration of 16-18 weeks, 2 hours per day and 5 days a week, with a minimum of 160 hours of instruction and 20 hours of home assignments.

### Eligibility

10+2 or Graduation in any discipline with 50% marks in aggregate
