

M. Phil. (Sanskrit)
Scheme of Examination (w.e.f. Session January 2020-21)

The duration of M. Phil. course will be one year (two semesters). There will be four theory papers in 1st Semester and two theory papers and a dissertation in 2nd Semester. For internal assessment the students are required to submit two assignments and present one seminar in each theory course except the course “Research and Publication Ethics’ (20MPCC1). The medium of the assignments and seminar will be Sanskrit. The dissertation will be of 200 marks (150+50).

Note- Syllabus for Ph.D. coursework will be same as in M. Phil. 1st Semester.

M. Phil. (Sanskrit)
Scheme of Examination (w.e.f. 2020-21)

The duration of M.Phil. course will be one year (two semesters). There will be four theory papers in 1st Semester and two theory papers and a dissertation in 2nd Semester. Theory papers at Sr. No. 1, 3 and 4 will carry 80 marks each and theory paper at Sr. no. 2 will carry 40 marks in 1st semester. There will be an internal assessment of 20 marks in theory papers at Sr. No. 1, 3 and 4 and 10 marks in theory paper at Sr. no. 2 in 1st semester. For internal assessment the students are required to present two assignments and one seminar in theory papers at Sr. No. 1, 3 and 4. The procedure of internal assessment in theory paper at Sr. no. 2 in 1st semester will be according to guidelines of the Ch. Ranbir Singh Institute of Social and Economic Change. The medium of the assignments and seminar will be Sanskrit. The dissertation will be of 200 marks (150+50).

Note- Syllabus for Ph.D. coursework will be same as in M. Phil. 1st Semester.
