Two books published by the Haryana State Higher Education Council (HSHEC) will be released on Friday, 10th June, 2022 at 11.30 am in Haryana Niwas, Sector 3, Chandigarh. Sh. Bandaru Dattatreya, Hon'ble Governor of Haryana will be the Chief Guest of the book release ceremony. Prof. Brij Kishore Kuthiala, Chairperson, HSHEC will also be present. 43 senior professors working in higher education institutions of the state have written the essays free of cost. Prof. Brij Kishore Kuthiala and Prof. Rajiv Kumar are the editors of both the books. On the recommendation of the Hon'ble Chief Minister, both the books have been published from the Government Press, Panchkula free of cost. Chairperson of the Council, Prof. Brij Kishore Kuthiala informed that the publication of two books i.e. 'Managing Education Post Covid: Challenges & Opportunities' और 'कोरोना काल में शिक्षा व्यावस्था चुनौतियां एवं संभावनाएं' is based on the education management during the Corona period. Prof. Kuthiala informed that a total of 13 essays are included in the book published in Hindi language and 24 essays are included in the book published in English language.

In the books to be released, Dr. Ajay Garg in his essay has attempted to see the virtual classroom as an alternative to current teaching system. Renowned educationist Prof. Somnath Sachdeva has elaborated on the importance of yoga education in the prevention of COVID epidemic in his essay. Prof. Harish Kumar has emphasized the importance of digital education system in the contemporary COVID scenario. Dr. Sudha Jain has thrown light on the ancient teaching methods and its utility in the present era. Dr. Rajendra Kumar Awasthi has highlighted upon the possible alternatives of e-education. Dr. Jyoti Juneja has stressed upon the need to incorporate Indian culture into the curriculum post pandemic. Dr. Vibha Aggarwal has elaborated on the various dimensions of teacher-student interaction. In the book 'Shiksha – Bharat athva India Ke Liye', scholar of Indian thought tradition, Late. Prof. Om Prabhat Agrawal has highlighted the necessity of education framework of Bharat in India. Shri Ramrati Malik has told about the various dimensions of teacher-student interaction. Dr. Kashyap Kumar Dubey has presented the challenges and suggestions in the perspective of digitalization of higher education in global pandemic. Dr. Sushma Joshi has discussed the challenges of online education, Dr. Rakesh Wadhwa on the necessity of teaching civic-education, and Dr. Asha Rani has highlighted the changes in life due to Covid-19, in their respective essays.

Prof. Brij Kishore Kuthiala informed that all the essay writers have been invited to the book release ceremony. He said that in the times of Corona crisis, the nature of education is changing through online education. Along with showing a new way to live life, Corona has inspired the human ability to be alone and experiment with oneself. To get out of this tough situation, teachers have done many new innovative experiments. Due to their experiments, the role of teachers again became important in spreading awareness in the society during the Corona period. Teachers are not only teaching the students online but have also become a bridge to spread awareness among student's parents. The trend of digital education has increased rapidly in the country and technology is being used in the teaching process. This changing nature of education is linked to digital industrial technology which gives the students a new learning approach.
