Greetings from Haryana State Higher Education Council!


Your kind attention is invited to the following UGC's guidelines:

- 1. National Higher Education Qualifications Framework (NHEQF)-** The main thrust of the policy regarding higher education is to transform HEIs into larger multidisciplinary universities, colleges and HEI clusters/Knowledge Hubs.
- 2. National Credit Framework (NCrF)-** The guideline is an inclusive one single meta framework to seamlessly integrate the credits earned through School Education, higher Education and vocational and skill education. It also provides for Assignment, Accumulation, Storage, Transfer and redemption of Credits.
- 3. Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes-** In accordance with NEP 2020, the UGC has formulated a new student-centric "Curriculum and Credit Framework for Undergraduate Programmes (CCFUP)" incorporating a flexible choice-based credit system, multidisciplinary approach and multi entry and exit options.
- 4. Guidelines for Multiple Entry and Exist in Academic Programmes offered in Higher Education Institutions-** Highlighting the importance of flexible learning, NEP 2020 states the imaginative and flexible curricular structures will enable creative combinations of disciplines for study and would offer multiple entry and exit points and thus, remove the currently prevalent rigid boundaries. The guideline is equipped with Validity of credits, Qualification type and Credit requirement for Graduation and Master courses.

Soft copy of the above guidelines are enclosed for reference.

It is hoped that the Universities might have initiated action on the above guidelines by now. Hence a request to share an updated status for record.
