Benefits of SWAYAM from University Perspective

- Multi-disciplinary Approach: Benefit to offer multi-disciplinary programs to students by combining best courses offered by other universities along with their existing structure. Further, in reference to UGC notification upto 40% credits can be claimed from SWAYAM.
- Universities will have opportunity to associate with the reputable brand name such as IIT and IIM, thereby strengthening their own brand reputation
- Universities have multiple options to oversee the administration of Exams for SWAYAM courses, offering higher flexibility
- Universities can attract more students who left earlier due to absence of specific elective courses
- Potential to boost student output by equipping students with Industry standard skills available on SWAYAM+ Newly Launched Industry Vertical
- Local chapters will be set up to assist universities/colleges ensuring the seamless implementation of SWAYAM courses
- Free Courses for learning enhancement and nominal prices for assessment

PPT has also spelt out action to be taken by the Universities/HEIs.
