Subject:-New technology platform Mera Yuva Bharat Portal to build an ecosystem to facilitate experiential learning for youth in diverse sectors

Greetings from Haryana State Higher Education Council!!

Kindly refer to the D.O. F. No. 5-19/2023/(NSQF) dated 25.11.2024 (letter enclosed) regarding the subject cited above. In line with the provisions of the National Education policy 2020, the Government has been working to build an ecosystem to facilitate experiential learning for youth in diverse sectors.

A new technology platform of the Department of youth Affairs, Government of India viz. Mera Yuva Bharat Portal (<https://mybharat.gov.in>) is designed to put in place an institutional mechanism for experiential learning. Knowledge institutions, schools and colleges are ideally placed to benefit from this mechanism. Experiential learning activities and volunteering for community service. are recognized as standard tools through which youth can improve their team-building, problem-solving and communication skills and their organizational abilities. The experiential learning feature of My Bharat portal offers the facility to connect youth to such opportunities.

To make better use of the portal, a facility has been created for such institutions to register themselves on the portal and to get a dedicated web page. This is to suggest that one could register the institution on My Bharat and become a partner as a Knowledge Institution. This could help enhance institution's reach pan-India and build a network with current and former students. Presence on My Bharat portal would enable to showcase institution and its multiple activities which would increase youth engagement. The portal also provides a dedicated profile page to every youth who registers on it, -which allows the youth to build a digital trail of all his/her works. including experiential learning done on MY Bharat, which may be converted into educational credit points.

Hence, a request to all the Universities to take further necessary action as suggested by UGC.
