An indicative list of programmes could include promotion of Indian languages in digital spaces, encourage innovation and research through Indian languages, multilingual cultural programmes, speeches, songs, games, fun activities, film screenings in different languages, seminars, workshops, debates, cuisine corners from different linguistic areas, exhibitions, language learning corners, interaction with authors, street plays, folk performances, etc.

It is also advised to disseminate information about these programmes widely so that people across the country feel connected on this important day.
