- 1. The oldest University in Haryana is Kurukshetra University, Kurukshetra established in the year 1956 and the youngest Universities are Maharishi Valmiki Sanskrit University, Kaithal and Shri Krishna Ayush University both established in the year 2018.
- 2. The approximate intake capacity in Public Universities is 31,087 students.
- 3. 96 Diploma courses are offered by 15 Public Universities.
- 4. 48 Certificate courses are offered by 11 Public Universities.
- 5. The UG programmes offered in 21 Public Universities is around 187.
- 6. The PG programmes offered in 19 Public Universities is around 512.
- 7. 240 Research programmes (Ph.D) are offered by 17 Public Universities.
- 8. 30 Dual Degrees courses are offered by 07 Public Universities.
- 9. Four Part-time courses are being offered by 02 Public Universities.
- 10. There are approximate 3,186 (includes regular, contractual etc.) faculty members and approximate 7,544 (includes regular, contractual etc.) supporting secretarial staff in Public Universities.

 - (b) The sanctioned strength for supporting secretarial posts is 4,587. Recruitment of the vacant sanctioned positions has been initiated on mission mode.

- 13. Number of Public Universities which are under Section 12(B) of UGC Act is 12.
- 14. Number of Public Universities which are **not** under Section 12(B) of UGC Act is 09.
